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## Inclusivity at Policy Level

- What guides the intervention? Are there laws, policies and reports that guide women and girls living with HIV programming
- Are the laws and policies supporting the efforts to end HIV?
- Do the laws and policies present barriers to women's and girls' ability to access HIV and health services?

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## Community mobilization and Consultative sessions with women and girls at all levels

- Mobilize community to set priority – *take it beyond national level*
- Support priority setting – resource person
- Identify key women and girls that can participate in the program application and ensure that the grant addresses the needs of women and girls in diversity
- Articulate how much of the grant actually address the plight of women and girls across the three diseases - AGYW ...
- Women and girls must play an oversight role and ensure that the gaps are well address

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## **Strengthening partnership and innovation collaboration - What works for women ??**

- Work with all women in diversity
- Strategize with key actors
- Create/ work on innovations that enable access to service for women and girls
- Research and document

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## **• Women and girls representative of the CCM**

- We need women and girls specific seat at CCM
